








Farewell to AMERICA

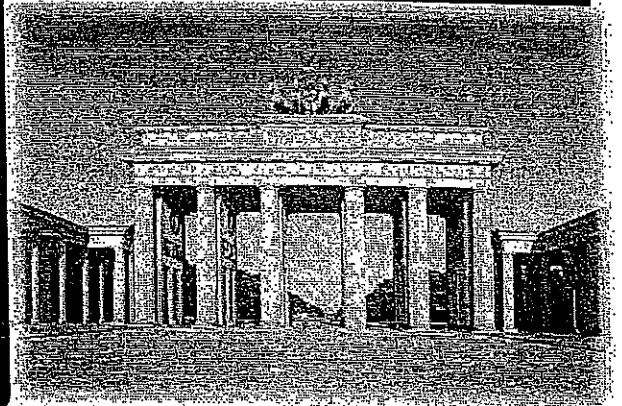
 "A quick stop along the way."

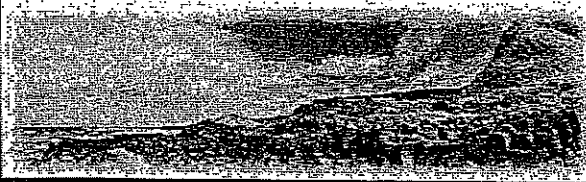


Welcome to IRELAND
